At 3:45 p.m. a **special meeting** was held by the Sandusky City Commission in the City Building Commission Chambers, 222 Meigs Street, with City Commissioners Dennis Murray, Brian Crandall, Brett Fuqua, Dave Waddington, Craig Stahl, Dannie Edmon and Dan Kaman in attendance; as well as the Charter Officers of City Manager Mike Will, Law Director Don Icsman, Finance Director Ed Widman, and the Acting Clerk of the City Commission Charmayne Brown. It was an open meeting.

President Kaman asked that Mr. Crandall offer the **prayer** and requested that everyone remain standing for the **Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag**.

President Kaman asked the Acting Clerk to **call the roll** with the following Commissioners present: Murray, Crandall, Fuqua, Waddington, Stahl, Edmon, and Kaman.

President Kaman asked for a **motion to make Charmayne Brown the Acting Clerk** for tonight's meeting in the absence of the Clerk. Mr. Fuqua said so moved. It was seconded by Mr. Waddington and carried unanimously.

Mr. Mike Will, City Manager, said they were here today to consider the passage of a resolution to support National Church Residences for their application for tax credits. This application would allow them to rehabilitate the Viewpoint Apartments.

President Kaman then asked the Law Director to read the resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 013-06R was read at first reading to support the National Church Residences application for low income tax credits from the Ohio Housing Finance Agency for the Viewpoint Apartments; and declaring that this Resolution shall take immediate effect in accordance with Section 14 of the City Charter. It was moved by Mr. Waddington and seconded by Mr. Crandall that this Resolution be passed under suspension of the rules in full accordance with Section 14 of the City Charter. Thereupon the Clerk called the roll with the following response: Yeas: Murray, Crandall, Fuqua, Waddington, Stahl, Edmon, Kaman, 7. Nays: 0. Thereupon the Clerk called the roll on final passage of the Resolution as follows: Yeas: Murray, Crandall, Fuqua, Waddington, Stahl, Edmon, Kaman, 7. Nays: 0. The President declared the Resolution passed.

At 4:00 p.m. President Kaman returned to the table and asked for motions to adjourn. It was moved by Mr. Waddington to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Mr. Crandall and carried unanimously.
