Is a convenient and easy way to get to work, appointments, shopping and more. Anyone can ride. There are no eligibility requirements.

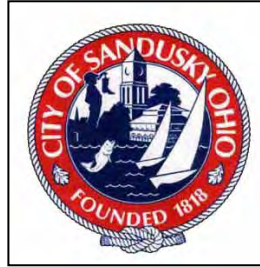
