

# 2008 LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

## Zones & Boundaries

### **Zone 1** *Nov. 6, 7, 10, 12, 13 & Dec. 8, 9, 10, 11*

East of Meigs Street and Sycamore Line to the City limits including Cedar Point Chaussee

### **Zone 2** *Nov. 13, 14, 17, 18, 19 & Dec. 11, 12, 15, 16*

West of Meigs Street & Sycamore Line to Columbus Avenue from Water Street to the railroad tracks

### **Zone 3** *Nov. 19, 20, 21, 24 & Dec. 16, 17, 18, 19*

West of Columbus Avenue to Camp Street from Sandusky Bay to the railroad tracks

### **Zone 4** *Nov. 24, 25, 26 & Dec. 1, 2, 19, 22, 23*

West of Camp Street, including the Venice Heights area

### **Zone 5** *Nov. 3, 4, 5, 6 & Dec. 2, 3, 4, 5*

South of the railroad, East of Camp Street to the city limits

## Leaf Collection Guidelines

- ◆ Leaves should be placed on the boulevard, beside the curb, preceding the first scheduled pickup day in your particular zone.
- ◆ Leaves should not be piled in the street as this makes collection difficult for our crews and increases the cost of disposing of the leaves. It can also cause blockages within the storm sewer system.
- ◆ No brush or foreign matter (including limbs and other yard waste) is to be included with the leaves as it damages and plugs the collection machinery which can result in delays to the schedule. Residents who participate in the city's weekly Yard Waste Collection program must keep leaves and yard waste separated.
- ◆ It is permissible to place leaves in biodegradable bags and left at the curb, on the boulevard, for pickup; these must be separated from other yard waste.
- ◆ If leaves are raked ahead of the designated scheduled pickup, they may be stored near the street, then simply raked to the curb/shoulder the day before the first scheduled pickup day.
- ◆ Vehicles should be parked off-street when leaf collection is scheduled to take place in your zone to allow the machinery to easily maneuver through the zone.
